Request for Voluntary Closure

1. Voluntary closure can be carried out on the advice of the **registered** owner(s) or in the case of a body corporate, the authorised officer **or** by the beneficial owner if supported by an **original** bill of sale.
2. All joint owners must sign the request.
3. This form is not to be used to request closure of registration in circumstances where a ship has been sold to non-qualified (foreign) owners.
